

# The New Labels

The Board had a new computer database program designed and installed this Spring. This database is much more powerful and will provide the staff the ability to track information more accurately and more efficiently.

One task that the database can provide is to print continuing education information on the mailing labels. If you have not already noticed, the mailing labels have a different appearance.

All auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers mailing labels will consist of not only their name and address, but the amount of continuing education hours the person currently has turned in to the Board's office.

On the labels, to the right of the individual's license number, will be the letters "CE" and two sets of numbers. The first number to the right of the letters "CE" will be from 0 to 4. This tells a licensee how many hours the Board has received from the licensee for the next renewal period, 2005-2006. If the number is 4, then the licensee has fulfilled his or her requirement for the next renewal period and he or she will receive a renewal application in May 2005.

The second number to the right of the letters "CE" will also be from 0 to 4. This tells a licensee how many hours the Board has received from the licensee which can be carried over for the renewal period, 2006-2007. If the number is 4, then the licensee will also have fulfilled his or her requirement for the following renewal period and he or she will also receive a renewal application in May 2006.

These mailing labels are used for any documents mailed to licensed auctioneers and apprentice auctioneers. These documents include notices, AANC magazines, Law and Rule books, renewal application materials, or any other correspondence that would be mailed from the Board's office to licensees.

Unfortunately, these type of labels cannot be used for auction firm licenses. This is because each designated person with an auction firm is required to attend continuing education. Many auction firms have multiple designated persons.
