

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SUBMISSIONS ON PROPOSED RULE, PROPOSED RULE READOPTIONS, AND PROPOSED REPEAL OF RULE THROUGH READOPTION

Notice is hereby given that the North Carolina Auctioneer Licensing Board has filed a Notice of Text with the Office of Administrative Hearings - Rules Review Commission, with publication in the NC Register set for November 15, 2019. The Board is proposing the items below as part of the scheduled rules readoption pursuant to the periodic rules review set forth in G.S. 150B-21.3:

- Adopt the rule cited as 21 [NCAC 04B .0203](#);
- Readopt with substantive changes the rules cited as [21 NCAC 04B .0101-.0104, .0201, .0202, .0301-.0303, .0401-.0405, .0501-.0506, .0601-.0607, .0801-.0810, .0812-.0819](#);
- Readopt without substantive changes the rule cited as [21 NCAC 04B .0701](#); and
- Repeal through readoption the rule cited as [21 NCAC 04B .0811](#).

The comment period will be open until January 14, 2020. If an objection is not resolved prior to the adoption of the rule, a person may also submit written objections to the Rules Review Commission after the adoption of the Rule. If the Rules Review Commission receives written and signed objections after the adoption of the Rule in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.3(b2) from 10 or more persons clearly requesting review by the legislature and the Rules Review Commission approves the rule, the rule will become effective as provided in G.S. 150B-21.3(b1). The Commission will receive written objections until 5:00 p.m. on the day following the day the Commission approves the rule. The Commission will receive those objections by mail, delivery service, hand delivery, or facsimile transmission.
