## AANC Member Requirement

As part of the new AANC policy, **ALL AANC members are required to complete 4 hours of CE each year — regardless of age.**

This policy ensures we continue raising the professional standard of our association and the services we provide to our clients.

### **North Carolina CE Requirements (Non-AANC Members)**

The North Carolina requirements are as follows:

- **4 Hours of CE must be completed by May 15th**
- Up to **4 hours may be rolled over (banked)**
- Licensed NC Auctioneers in Active status who are **over 65 years of age and have been licensed at least five years** are exempt from the annual 4-hour CE requirement

Regardless of exemption status, **all licensees are allowed and strongly encouraged to complete continuing education courses**, including those offered through this program.

*Please note: This exemption applies only to auctioneers. It does not apply to apprentice auctioneers or designated person(s) of a firm.*
